Any current Grade 6 student who wishes to apply to one or more of our Special Programs is required to follow this Application Process. Please be aware that this process is in addition to the process to enrol your child for Year 7 at Narre Warren South P-12 College.

Monday 18 th March	Year 7 Information Evening
<i>All parents and students currently in Grade 6 are invited to attend a presentation from our Secondary Leadership Team at the College. This presentation will include information about our school and programs. There will be an opportunity to ask questions of staff on this night.</i>	
Friday 10 th May 4pm	Special Programs Applications due
<i>All students who are intending to apply for one of our five Special Programs must submit their application by this date. Applications can be completed online, via http://www.nwsc.vic.edu.au/learning/special-programs.html. Hard copy application forms are available upon request.</i>	
Saturday 18 th May 9am – 11am	STEM – Testing
<i>Students applying for the Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics program are required to attend an entrance test. This test will be held at the College in A Block. Students to meet in the Year 7 Courtyard (near the entrance to the Gym and Year 7 play equipment). Students should bring basic stationery, a snack and a drink.</i>	
Monday 20 th to Thursday 23 rd May	PTS – Fitness Testing and Try Outs
<i>Students applying for the Pathways Through Sport program may be invited to attend a Fitness Test after school at the College one day this week. If invited, students should wear clothing suitable for physical activities and bring a bottle of water. Please note that not all PTS applicants will be invited to attend this part of the application process.</i>	
Wednesday 12 th June	All Programs – interviews
<i>Students applying for all programs are required to attend an interview. Interviews will take place during the school day and will be approximately 10-15 minutes in length. Interviews will take place at the College and you will be advised of your Interview time after applying. Parents should attend with their child. Unfortunately, there will be no scope to reschedule interviews once times are allocated.</i>	
August	Program Offers Sent
<i>We will contact all families to advise them of the outcome of their Program Application. Students who are unsuccessful may, at the discretion of the College, be placed on a waiting list should space become available in the Program throughout 2020.</i>
