STEAM is everywhere. Our health, safety, relationships with family and friends and even our jobs are shaped by the innovation in technology that we discover in science. Economies are built around new technologies that help to find new and better ways of doing things. STEAM skills are becoming increasingly important in the workforce as employers are aiming to recruit technicians and trade workers with STEAM skills.

How do you prepare young people for future jobs that don't exist yet? How many of the jobs currently available will be automated within the next 5 years? Are the skills learnt more important than the knowledge?

The "Foundation for young Australians" analysed over 4.2 million online jobs during the 2012-2015 period and found that the demand for "Enterprise Skills" are on the rise. Skills such as: problem solving, communications, critical thinking, creativity, teamwork presentation skills and digital and financial literacy.

The STEAM program will start from Year 7 where students will be work on developing skills in problem solving, analysis and interpretation of data, as well as enhancing their own skills to help them in their future careers. Each term there will be up to two major projects that will be undertaken. These projects will encourage the students to solve authentic problems and work together in teams or even as a class to build real solutions.
